ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE HARVEY W. BROADIE, JR. SCHOLARSHIP

I. Graduating Seniors

A. Church Life

Each Applicant must:

- Be an active member of First Baptist Church of Highland Park for at least one full year.
- Participate in one or more church activities, such as youth program, usher board, choir, Sunday Biblical Institute (SBI), Sunday Nursery, etc.
- Attend church services and/or SBI regularly.
- Must attend the Crown Ministry Class for Teens. This requirement is mandatory unless the student can show that they have taken another financial literacy course that we deem as acceptable. We will also note your involvement in JAM, SBI, and Ministry participation.
- B. Academic Life

Each Applicant must:

- Have been accepted to an accredited college, university, or trade school.
- Submit enrollment proof from school of acceptance.
- Begin attending school for the fall or spring semester after his/her senior year.
- II. <u>Continuing and/or Previously Graduated Students</u>. The criteria are the same as above with the understanding that the applicant may be or may have been away because of school.

III. Disbursement of Scholarships

The amount of the scholarship will depend upon the amount of monies and the number of applicants. First time graduating seniors will be given priority. Continuing and previously graduated students will be allocated monies based on remaining funds and the number of applicants.

- 1. It is the intent of the program to give every eligible, college-bound graduating senior a minimum of \$1,000.
- 2. It is the intent to give every eligible, continuing and/or previously graduated student a minimum of \$300.
- 3. High achievers may be considered for additional funds depending on the availability of funds.

DEADLINE

ALL APPLICATIONS ARE DUE ON OR BEFORE <u>MAY 31, 2025.</u> APPLICATIONS MUST BE POSTMARKED OR STAMPED BY THE OFFICE STAFF NO LATER THAN THE DUE DATE OF <u>MAY 31, 2025</u>.

IV. Students attending any of the five military academies are ineligible for the Harvey W. Broadie, Jr. Scholarship.
