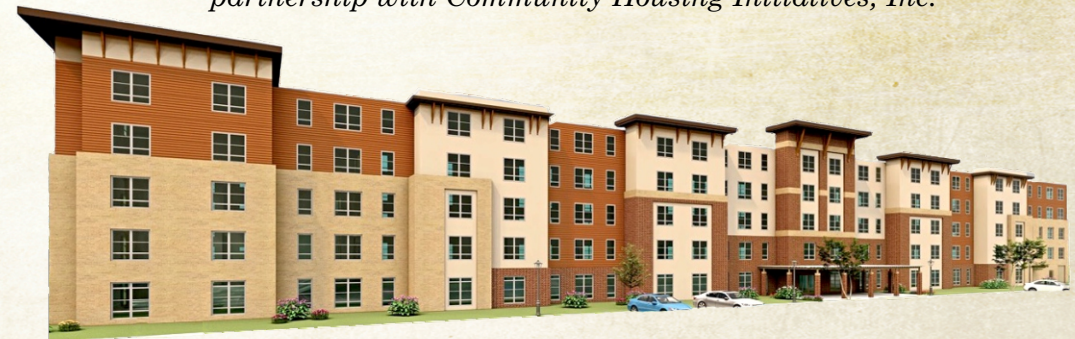


Pastoral Greetings

Today, we break ground on "The Highlands", a premier Senior Residential community. This project is a testament of our shared commitment to our treasured senior citizens. But this project is more than just a building; it is a promise of safe, affordable, and accessible homes where our seniors can thrive and remain in the neighborhoods they have loved and built.

This development will feature 137 senior apartment homes, 89 - one bedroom and 48 two bedroom homes.
