Opening Charge

Good morning, family!

Before you check your schedule...  
Before you replay yesterday...  
Before you start worrying about what didn't happen...

I came to tell you something prophetic and powerful:

**You still have fire left.**

Life tried to wear you down...  
Situations tried to cool you off...  
People tried to discourage you...

But if you're still here this morning...

**That means the fire never went out—it just needs to be stirred!**

**1. The Fire May Be Low—But It's Not Gone**

Paul tells Timothy to fan into flames—which suggests something important:

The fire wasn't dead... it was just dim.

- Some of you aren't empty — you're just exhausted.
- You're not finished—you're just fatigued.
- You're not defeated—you're just dealing with a lot.

But hear me:

God never gave you something that life could take away.

What He placed in you is still there!

## 2. You Have a Responsibility to Stir It Up

Paul didn't say, "Wait on God to relight it."

He said: Fan it. Stir it. Work it.

### Which means:

- Pray even when you don't feel like it
- Praise even when it's quiet
- Show up even when it's hard

Because sometimes a breakthrough doesn't come from starting over...

It comes from stirring up what you already have.

## 3. Your Fire Is Connected to Your Future

The enemy doesn't fight you because of where you are...

He fights you because of what's in you.

### That fire is:

- Your calling
- Your strength
- Your assignment
- Your next level

If there's still fire in you... there's still MORE for you!

### Say it out loud:

**"I STILL HAVE FIRE!"**

**"IT'S NOT OVER!"**

**"GOD ISN'T FINISHED WITH ME YET!"**

If there's still fire in you... there's still purpose for you!
