GOD IS SUSTAINING YOU RIGHT NOW

Have you ever felt like you're running on empty—but somehow still moving forward? That's not luck. That's not coincidence. That's God sustaining you. The truth is, not every season feels strong—but every season can be supported. You may not feel like shouting, but you're still standing. You may not have all the answers, but you haven't given up. And that's evidence that God is holding you together even when life tries to pull you apart. Isaiah 40:29 (NLT) reminds us: "He gives power to the weak and strength to the powerless." Notice—God doesn't wait for you to be strong. He steps in when you're weak. So, if you're tired this week...If you're stretched...If you're carrying more than you ever expected...Be encouraged: God is not just watching you—He's strengthening you. You are not surviving by accident. You are being sustained on purpose. And here's the good news—If He's kept you this far, He's going to carry you the rest of the way. You may feel weak—but you are still being held by a strong God.



It is our prayer that you have started off the year strong with your giving. Remember that the Tithe is the first tenth off the top and that lines us up for blessings from God for our faith and faithfulness. This is more than just talking faith, but it is demonstrating how much you love the Lord and trust His Word.

Reasons Why You Should Tithe

Tithe: To tithe is to freely give one-tenth of one's income annually to the Lord through His Church.

1. It is Biblical – Approved by God in Old and New Testaments —
 - Malachi 3:10; Matthew 23:23
2. To Show Your Love Toward God – Song of Solomon 8:7
3. It Demonstrates that you put God and His work first – Matthew 6:33
4. It is a Testimony that you recognize and acknowledge God's ownership –
 - Psalm 24:1
5. It Helps to Spread the Gospel – 1 Corinthians 9:14
6. Because You Want to Avoid a Curse and Escape Condemnation – Malachi 3:8-9
7. It is an act of worship – Nehemiah 10:38
8. It is Holy unto the Lord and it belongs to Him – Leviticus 27:30
9. It gives confidence in the practice of prayer – 1 John 3:22
10. God's blessings are upon individuals who will tithe – Proverbs 3:9, 10
