STILL STANDING—AND STILL MOVING

“Our help is from the Lord, who made heaven and earth.”
Psalm 124:8 (NLT)

There are seasons in life when the victory is not in how fast you move...but in the fact that you didn't quit. You may not be where you thought you would be by now. You may have faced setbacks, delays, and moments that tried to shake your confidence. But here's the good news: If you're still here, God is not finished. The Psalmist declared in Psalm 124 that if it had not been for the Lord on our side, we would have been overwhelmed. That means every step you've taken, every tear you've cried, and every battle you've survived is evidence that God has been holding you up all along. So don't measure your progress by what hasn't happened yet. Measure it by what didn't take you out. You're still standing. And because you're still standing – you're still moving. Keep praying. Keep trusting. Keep showing up. Because the same God who kept you...is the same God who will carry you forward. In other words, “If God kept you through it, **He's** going to bring you through it.

It is our prayer that you have started off the year strong with your giving. Remember that the Tithe is the first tenth off the top and that lines us up for blessings from God for our faith and faithfulness. This is more than just talking faith, but it is demonstrating how much you love the Lord and trust His Word.

Reasons Why You Should Tithe

Tithe: To tithe is to freely give one-tenth of one's income annually to the Lord through His Church.

1. ***It is Biblical – Approved by God in Old and New Testaments —***
 - *Malachi 3:10; Matthew 23:23*
2. ***To Show Your Love Toward God – Song of Solomon 8:7***
3. ***It Demonstrates that you put God and His work first – Matthew 6:33***
4. ***It is a Testimony that you recognize and acknowledge God's ownership –***
 - *Psalm 24:1*
5. ***It Helps to Spread the Gospel – 1 Corinthians 9:14***
6. ***Because You Want to Avoid a Curse and Escape Condemnation – Malachi 3:8-9***
7. ***It is an act of worship – Nehemiah 10:38***
8. ***It is Holy unto the Lord and it belongs to Him – Leviticus 27:30***
9. ***It gives confidence in the practice of prayer – 1 John 3:22***
10. ***God's blessings are upon individuals who will tithe – Proverbs 3:9, 10***
