## SEE IT BEFORE YOU SEE IT

“Faith shows the reality of what we hope for; it the evidence of the things we cannot see.”  
Hebrews 11:1(NLT)

There will be moments in life when nothing around you matches what God has spoken over you. The situation may look uncertain, the resources may seem limited, and the timing may feel off—but faith is not based on what you see. Faith is based on what God said. Faith gives you the ability to see beyond your current conditions and into God’s diving possibilities. It allows you to walk into rooms you’re not fully ready for yet, trust doors you didn’t open yourself, and believe for outcomes that haven’t shown up—yet. This is the kind of faith that built communities, sustained generations, and carried our ancestors through what they could not see but still believed. They didn’t have all the evidence—but they had enough faith to keep moving. And that same faith is in you. So this week, don’t just look at what is—start seeing what can be. Don’t just focus on what’s missing—focus on what God is manifesting. Don’t just walk by sight—walk by faith. Because what you see by faith today...you’ll walk into by reality tomorrow.

*It is our prayer that you have started off the year strong with your giving. This is more than just talking faith, but it is demonstrating how much you love the Lord and trust His Word.*

  - Malachi 3:10; Matthew 23:23
2. To Show Your Love Toward God – Song of Solomon 8:7
3. It Demonstrates that you put God and His work first – Matthew 6:33
4. It is a Testimony that you recognize and acknowledge God’s ownership –
  - Psalm 24:1
5. It Helps to Spread the Gospel – 1 Corinthians 9:14
6. Because You Want to Avoid a Curse and Escape Condemnation – Malachi 3:8-9
7. It is an act of worship – Nehemiah 10:38
8. It is Holy unto the Lord and it belongs to Him – Leviticus 27:30
9. It gives confidence in the practice of prayer – 1 John 3:22
10. God’s blessings are upon individuals who will tithe – Proverbs 3:9, 10
