- 7. It is an act of worship – Nehemiah 10:38*
- 8. It is Holy unto the Lord and it belongs to Him – Leviticus 27:30*
- 9. It gives confidence in the practice of prayer – 1 John 3:22*
- 10. God's blessings are upon individuals who will tithe – Proverbs 3:9, 10*

*“Those who trust in the Lord will find new strength. They will soar high on wings like eagles.
Isaiah 40:31(NLT)*

There are moments in life when exhaustion does not come from physical labor alone – it comes from carrying pressure, disappointment, uncertainty, and silent battles that nobody else can fully see. Many people walk into church every week smiling on the outside while quietly fighting weariness on the inside. Yet the Good news of our faith is that God never asks us to carry life by ourselves. This week do not simply pray for God to change your circumstances – pray for Him to renew your strength while you move through them. Sometimes God does not remove the mountain immediately, but He gives you the strength to climb it. He renews your mind when stress tries to overwhelm you. He steadies your heart when anxiety whispers fear. He restores your hope when life feels heavy. The eagles are unique because it does not waste energy fighting every storm. Instead, it learns how to use the wind beneath its wings to rise higher. In the same way, what was designed to discourage you can become the very thing God uses to elevate you. The pressure may be real, but so is the power of God working within you. You may feel tired, but you are not abandoned. You may feel stretched, but your future is still in God’s hands. The Lord knows how to breathe fresh strength into weary people. He knows how to revive joy, restore peace, and renew vision. As you move through this week, remind yourself daily:

- God is still with me.
- God is still strengthening me.
- God is still working on my behalf.
- And because of Him, I will rise again.
