UNSHAKABLE

“Therefore, since we are receiving a Kingdom that is unshakable, let us be thankful and please God by worshipping Him with holy fear and awe.” Hebrews 12:28 (NLT)

This week, as we continue moving forward in faith, never forget that God has not called us to live based on what shakes around us, but on Who stands beneath us. We are living in uncertain times filled with breaking news, changing economies, emotional strain, family pressures, and spiritual fatigue. Many people are carrying burdens silently while trying to keep smiling publicly. Yet even in a world that feels unstable, the people of God are anchored by something greater than circumstances –we are anchored by the unshakable Kingdom of God. Being “unshakable” does not mean that we never feel pressure. It does not mean we never cry, question, or become weary. It means that even when life pushes against us, we refuse to let go of God. Storms may bend us, but they do not have to break us. Delays may frustrate us, but they do not cancel God’s promises. Opposition may rise, but greater is the Spirit of God within us than anything working against us. Sometimes God allows shaking not to destroy us, but to reveal what is solid. Difficult seasons have a way of exposing what we truly trust. When everything temporary starts falling away, we discover that God’s grace is still sufficient, His strength is still available, and His mercy is still new every morning. What the enemy hoped would weaken you has instead become evidence that God has been sustaining you all along. This is why we must continue to pray with confidence, worship with sincerity, serve with joy, and love with consistency. Every act of faith becomes a declaration that we still believe God is working behind the scenes. Your testimony is not just that you survived difficult days – your testimony is that God kept you steady while walking through them. As a church family, let us encourage one another to remain faithful, hopeful, and spiritually grounded. Keep your eyes on God even when the world becomes distracting. Keep your spirit open even when life becomes heavy. Keep believing even when answers seem delayed. The God who has carried us this far will continue to lead us forward.
