“Therefore, since we are receiving a Kingdom that is unshakable, let us be thankful and please God by worshipping Him with holy fear and awe.” **Hebrews 12:28 (NLT)**

Life has a way of testing our stability. One phone call can change a day. One diagnosis can change a season. One disappointment can challenge everything we thought we knew. 8. **It is Holy unto the Lord and it belongs to Him – Leviticus 27:30**
9. **It gives confidence in the practice of prayer – 1 John 3:22**
10. **God’s blessings are upon individuals who will tithe – Proverbs 3:9, 10**

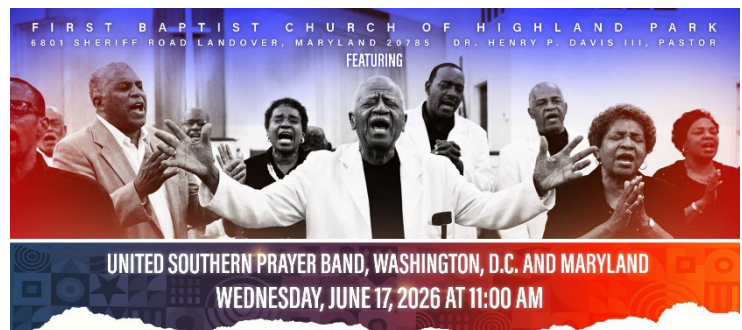
